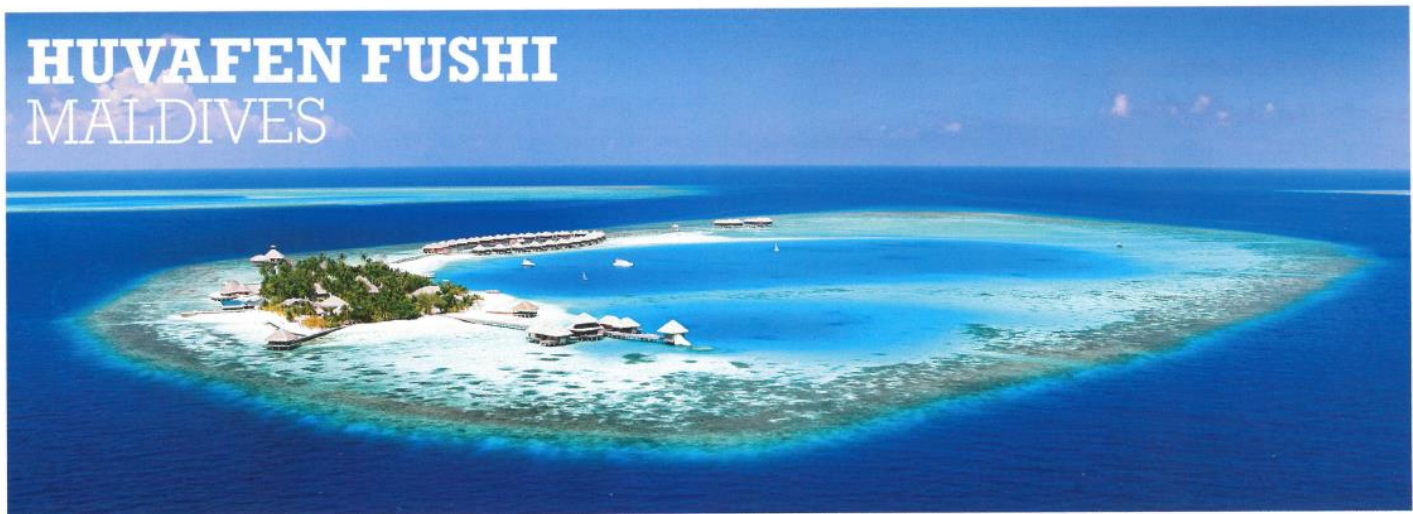

Spring break: spas to revive after winter blues



## HUVAFEN FUSHI MALDIVES

### Where is it?

A private island in the North Malé Atoll in the Maldives, located south-west of Sri Lanka in the Indian Ocean.

### What's the appeal?

The resort forms part of an atoll, and is only accessible by boat. A crystal-clear lagoon provides sheltered swimming, while the coral reefs as far as they eye can see offer ample diving opportunities.

### What makes it special?

For those who either don't fancy or physically can't participate in dives on the coral reef, underwater exploration is not out of the question. Huvafen Fushi has created the world's first underwater spa, with amazing views of the local wildlife in their natural habitat from two of the treatment rooms.



### Dining

There are six restaurants and bars to choose from, each trying to outdo the other for originality. Vinum is eight metres below sea level in an underground cellar, and holds 6,000 wines, many of them of a rare vintage. The more casual Raw has its focus on healthy living, in a relaxed setting on a wooden platform over the water. Others allow you to dine with your feet in the sand or in the infinity pool, under



starlight or in the cool shade of a sheltered hut over the water.

### Wellness

Two of the spa's treatment rooms are in their own underwater, technicolour paradise. A jaw-dropping menu includes the 'Champagne & Truffles' facial: a 90-minute treatment with a facial mask formed of champagne, silk, diamonds, gold and black truffles. Thermal zones, sauna and steam rooms, a saltwater

flotation pool and an over-water gym and yoga pavilion complete the experience.

### Our favourite room

It's a tough call between the Cube, a three bedroom, 463 square metre personal paradise with private pool and direct access to the beach, or one of the ocean pavilions on stilts. An optic-lit infinity pool overlooking the ocean spreads out from the living room to the outdoor deck, which also includes day beds, a Jacuzzi and barbecue grill.

### How to get there

Fly to Malé International Airport. A hotel representative will meet you as you clear customs and whisk you off in a private speedboat for the 40-minute trip to Huvafen Fushi.
